BOYCOTT DECLARATION

Boycott Campaign against the Election of the Vietnam Communist National Assembly 2021, The Executive powers office, Authorities, Constitution and Communist Party of Vietnam.

To the following people:

- United Nations Secretary-General and Representatives of Countries Where Courts Apply the "Global Magnitsky Act,"
- Presidents and Prime Ministers of the Nations of the World,
- ^o Embassies, Representative Officers of the Existing Democratic Nations in Vietnam,
- ° Congressmen of the World,
- Leaders of International Civil Societies, Communications Organizations, and Religions of the World,
- Leaders of Organizations, Communities, and Parties Fighting against the Vietnamese Communist Party in Vietnam and Abroad,
- Vietnamese at Home and Abroad.

We, the co-signed below, including members of all Vietnamese ethnic groups at home and abroad, simultaneously launched the campaign to boycott the election of the National Assembly of Vietnam (NAVN) from now until May 23, 2021, in the following forms:

1. Communications Network Campaign

- Calling and mobilizing Vietnamese around the world by opening the communications networks at home and abroad in the weekly information program.
- Analyzing the Vietnamese Communist Regime's constitution to point out the dictatorship, backwardness, nonethnic, antidemocratic methods that have led the country to the disaster of a corrupt society and loss of the country to China's hand.
- Presenting and explaining the progressive humanism in the constitution of the Republic of Vietnam and then comparing it with the antidemocratic constitution of the Vietnamese Communist Regime(VCR).
- Mobilizing the people in Vietnam to fight and abolish the current VCR, China's slave. The Vietnamese Communist Party(VCP) and the NAVN have used violence to control all media; to deceive, deny, silence, or hide authentic information; and to detain dissident citizens.

2. Comprehensive Civil Disobedience Campaign

- Calling and mobilizing people at home and abroad to participate in opposing the VCP's antidemocratic national assembly election hoax that only represents the Communist Party members, and absolutely does not represent the Vietnamese people.
- Calling for a comprehensive civil disobedience effort by all Vietnamese people to cross out all the candidates' names on the ballots. Let us boycott the National Assembly, the Executive powers office, Authorities, Communist Party of Vietnam and the entire Constitution of the VCR and claim the right to our own nation's ownership that all citizens have equal rights, have the freedom to become candidates, and have the freedom to vote as clearly stated in the Universal Declaration of Human Rights and Civil Rights of the United Nations.
- 3. Campaign to Condemn the Executive powers office, the Government Authorities, Constitution, Communist Party of Vietnam. and National Assembly of Vietnam

- Condemning the nature of the Executive powers office, the Government Authorities, Constitution, Communist Party of Vietnam and the National Assembly of Vietnam, which are slaves of the China Communist party (CCP). They are treasonous, foreign henchmen for giving away the land of our country including the Paracel Islands, Spratly Islands, Nam Quan Fort, Bån Giốc Waterfall, critical peaks highlands along the Vietnam and China border; for adopting Formosa, Mekong, and the Bauxite plant that were damaging the environment and destroying fishing beds and resources in the exclusive economic zone in the Southeast Sea of Vietnam.
- Supporting and calling for participation in national protests to protect the environment and to fight against special economic zones and cybersecurity laws. We must oppose the VCP's violation of signed treaties such as the Convention on Human Rights International and the 1973 Paris Peace Accords.

4. Condemn the Campaign of the Acute Chinese Communist's Crimes

- Denouncing CCP that has robbed and occupied the Paracel Islands and Spratly Islands and threatened the Southeast Sea security.
- Boycott the Winter Olympics in Beijing 2022 (February 4, 2022);
- Boycotting all "toxic" goods made in China.
- Calling for an investigation of the biological weapon COVID from Wuhan that has damaged national economies and global human life.
- Condemning the Xinjiang genocide, the appropriation of Tibet, the murder of the Falun Gong, and Hong Kong's persecution and threatening of Taiwan and surrounding countries.
- Disseminating books, articles, and information internationally about the crimes of CCP who have deceived the world from the early twentieth century to the present.

5. The National Resurrection of Self-Determination Rights Campaign

- Reviving the national self-determination act by mobilizing the fundamental legal values from the Republic of Vietnam's constitution and advocating for a forum of the Peoples', of all People, and all organizations, because all attendees are equal and free to contribute their modalities to the homeland and the people to progress to a joint conference for the Peoples', by the Peoples'. A necessary conference discusses and proceeds to form parliaments like Tibetans or Uighurs. A conference with the participation of all Peoples' in the spirit of Peoples' Self-Determination (Peoples' Self-Determination approved by the United Nations General Assembly*).
- Focusing on these campaigns will be the essential political solution to conduct the fight in rescuing our country from the CCP; to deliver freedom for 96 million Vietnamese from dictatorship, corruption, and treason; and to rebuild Vietnamese independence and the rule of laws through democracy, sovereignty, freedom, and prosperity.
